

Lifeguard Job Description

- The Lifeguard will be called upon to undertake the duties in supervising the pool area to ensure the safety of all the pool users
- Arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start time to prepare the pool for the start of the session
- To ensure you have a knowledge and understanding of the NOP and EAP in order to follow and implement them if such an event occurs
- Understand the layout and change over times for swimming lessons so they can be done as fast as possible
- Check all safety and first aid equipment prior to start of shift
- To administer any necessary first aid
- Wear the correct uniform provided making sure that you are neat and presentable
- Treat all parents and children with courtesy and respect
- To remain vigilant and pro-active to ensure the safety of all users in the pool
- Maintain all lifeguarding skills and fitness by attending monthly training
- To ensure that changing rooms and building are kept in immaculate condition i.e. floors dry, toilets and urinals are clean and odour free.
- To keep the store room neat, tidy and all equipment is stored in an orderly fashion
- Assist in the walking school children to and from the school and pool for the curriculum swimming lessons.
- To undertake and perform any other task the centre management requires
